

The 2nd ADVISE Workshop - Madrid 4th December 2014

ADVISE Prototype: Discovering Criminal Acts and Following Criminal Trails in Public and Private Video Surveillance Archives

The 2nd workshop of the ADVISE research project will take place in Madrid (Spain), at the Madrid Council premises on the 4th of December 2014.

The **ADVISE** Workshop aims to demonstrate the achievements of the ADVISE project and promote the opportunity represented by **ADVISE** the improvement of European citizen security in a world of increasing vandalism terrorist activities. The workshop will include live



demonstration of the ADVISE system and a visit to the Integrated Centre for Security and Emergencies in Madrid (CISEM). Specifically, participants will have the opportunity to test the tool themselves in two different scenarios - private facility and public streets - and evaluate its relevance, innovation and benefits with regards to current investigation practices.

The Agenda

The <u>programme</u> foresees a visit to the Integrated Centre for Security and Emergencies in Madrid (CISEM) in the morning, and the presentation of the project and the pilots in the afternoon. The participants will be able to test the tool, try the two different scenario implemented and effectively contribute to its evaluation.

The Participants

The participants, which are expected from all around Europe, will be mainly operator and expert of the security sector, involved both in the fight against crimes directly (such as police forces) and indirectly, as consultants and experts in profiling criminals and crimes in general.

The practical session

In the practical session the participants will be involved in the usage of the tool and they will be able to follow criminal trails in the videos made available for tests, by using both the scenarios of public streets and private facilities.

Through guided demonstrations, the participants will be therefore able to interact with the tool, and deeply understand how it is working, in order to have a clear feeling about the concrete possibility to use the tool in a real world.
